We are holding these evenings as our data from 2019 indicated that boys needed a boost with their reading and writing and our girls needed a boost with mathematics. We know that the partnership between home and school is crucial to help support progress with our learners.

Te Reo Maori Lessons

This year we have employed Whaea Carol, our kapa haka tutor, to come in and teach Te Reo Maori to all our Y2-6 students. Carol is a registered teacher who taught in a bilingual unit and was senior teacher for the unit. Carol has 42 years' experience as a teacher and we are so lucky that she is working with our tamariki to build their confidence in speaking te reo. You could ask your child to share some of the things they are learning.

Wellness and Hauora This year Bayview School and the Kaipatiki Kahui Ako have a focus on wellbeing and hauora for both students and staff. At the end of 2019 we surveyed our children and found out the following:

- 37% of students say they are being teased/name called in a mean way - weekly/daily
- •95% of students agree/strongly agree that at school they are taught what to say or do if other children are being mean or bullying them
- •75% of Bayview students say they treat each other with respect (Kahui Ako average 75%)
- •87% of students agree/strongly agree that they stand up for other children if someone is mean to them (Kahui Ako average 78%)
- •80% of students agree/strongly agree that they can ask teachers for help.

This is only some of the data but it shows that we have some teaching to do as we want our results to be better! Teachers have unpacked this data and will be working on this with classes. I will share the rest of the data in our next newsletter.


