Dear Team Bayview

I must thank each of you for the support you have given us this year. We are definitely stronger together.

In these uncertain times with new cases of covid being diagnosed daily, we want to reassure you that we are continuing to encourage our learners to wash their hands frequently and use the hand sanitiser available throughout the school. We are also regularly reinforcing hygiene messages around sneezing, coughing into elbows and staying home if you are sick. We have had a number of learners having to be off school with winter colds in the last few weeks. Thank you for keeping them at home as it reduces the infection in others.

I would just like to clarify that you are welcome to come back onsite now we are at alert level one. You are welcome to visit the office to purchase second hand uniforms or to bring in forgotten lunchboxes or for whatever you may need to. You are welcome to walk your child to class if this is something you would like to do. If it suits you to drop at the gate then feel free to do that. We want you to know that you are welcome and we are happy to work alongside you and what works for you.

It has been an incredibly long term this term and our learners have been amazing at settling back into a somewhat normal school routine, but they are very tired! We know with two weeks break they will catch up on sleep and rest and will return next term full of life. Just a reminder that term 2 finishes on

Friday 3rd July at 2pm.

LOST PROPERTY

Our lost property is kept in the corridor between habitats 3 and 4. There are a lot of jumpers as our learners tend to wear them out to break times, get hot, and take them off and leave them on courts or decks. It is much easier to find the owners of named property so please take the time to name all your child's belongings.

GATE AT SIMON ELLICE ENTRANCE

The Bayview School Board of Trustees have decided to install a gate at the top of the Simon Ellice walkway. This gate will be aluminium and will allow us the ability to lock this entrance to the school when necessary. This will help us with learners who may wish to leave the grounds during school time and stop PE equipment rolling down the alleyway. Most of the time the gate will be left closed but unlocked so the community can still access our grounds. If the gate is locked please respect this as it will be done for a very important reason such as the safety of our learners.

This gate will probably be installed during the July break but we will let you know once this has been confirmed.

PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL

We all know that traffic around the school can be horrendous in the mornings and then again at 3pm. In the past we have had Auckland Transport come out and complete a needs analysis for a kiss and drop zone. Their feedback was that our parents were well behaved compared with other schools and they declined our request. With our growing roll I am going to ask them to come and conduct another needs analysis. In the interim I ask that parents STOP parking on the yellow lines directly outside the school to drop children off as this contravenes traffic laws and creates issues for our crossing. Please drop off safely with EVERY child's safety taken into consideration. The Simon Ellice entrance has far fewer traffic issues and I encourage you to use this entrance if you can. A reminder also not to park in the top carpark please either before or after school as this creates a hazard.

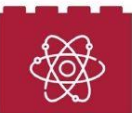
