I have heard of other schools where some learners have still not returned and schools where the parents are causing issues at the gates. I am so grateful that at Bayview we all work together for everyone's safety and peace of mind!

Out of Zone applications

Our out of zone applications are now open for parents wanting to enrol their child at Bayview School but who live out of our school zone. All the schools in our vicinity now have a school zone and these can be found on each school's website. Please note this also applies to all Intermediate Schools.

Year 6 Intermediate Schools

It is very important that if you have a child moving to intermediate school for the 2021 academic year that you enrol them now. Schools will be starting their process of contacting contributing primary schools for information about students enrolling at their school and determining class placement.

Carpark resurface work

During this term break our lower carpark is going to be resurfaced to sort out the potholes and uneven surface. There will be many trucks, diggers, rollers, etc in and around this area. There will be no parking available in the lower carpark whilst this work is completed. This may affect you if you are dropping your child off to the holiday programme or you are attending an event at the Bayview Community Centre. They are due to be completed by the beginning of term 4 so fingers crossed the weather remains fine and allows this work to be completed on time. If not please be mindful when term 4 begins.

Fire and Security Upgrade

We are currently having our fire and security systems upgraded. In the upcoming weekends and during the term break there will be some work where parts of the school are dug up to lay cabling. This means there will be diggers and trucks, etc around the school which may pose a danger to unsupervised children. The workmen will be following health and safety protocols but you may wish to accompany your children up to school if they are playing here during those times.

Life Education

Next term we have the Life Education Caravan coming to Bayview. Under the Government's donation scheme we will not be asking for money for your child to attend this and as it is part of the curriculum and on school grounds we do not need to ask your permission for your child to attend. This is an amazing resource that comes to Bayview School every second year. Our teachers work closely with the Life Education teacher to develop programmes specific to the needs of each Habitat. The caravan will be onsite from 20 -27 November.

TEACHER ONLY DAY - School will be closed

On **Tuesday 27th October** (which is the day after Labour Day holiday) we will be holding a teacher only day as we work on assessment. We thank you in advance for making alternative arrangements as the school will be closed on this day. We thank you for your support around this.

Term 4 events

You may be wondering if any of our usual term 4 events will be going ahead with the current pandemic. At this stage we are planning for all contingencies. This means we have a plan for the possibility of being in either AL1, AL2 or AL3 or 4. At this stage we are planning as if we will be in Alert Level 1 and can proceed as we normally would. If required we will modify these events to cater for any and all alert level requirements. We will keep you updated as much as we can.

End of Term 3

Term 3 finishes at **2pm** on **Friday 25th September**. Term 4 starts on **Monday 12th October**. We hope you have a lovely term break with your children where there is no expectation of home learning! The children are really tired and I am sure you are as well. This is a great time to relax and unwind and just have some fun!
